### **South East Asia**

#### **The Lion Rock Institute Internship, Hong Kong**

*Early December to End January (students may return to Perth for Christmas at their own cost)*

The successful applicant would work on public policy projects and learn about the workings of the most economically free country in the world (according to Heritage Foundation's Annual Index of Economic Freedom (<http://www.heritage.org/index/ranking>)). The objective of this internship is for the applicant selected to work on short policy and 'op-ed' style pieces, while also assisting senior members of the Lion Rock team to develop their *capitalism.HK* quarterly publication.
