



### **Overview**

The Mannkal Economic Education Foundation proposes sending one Western Australian Tertiary student to Canada to work as a policy intern at the Fraser Institute in Vancouver, Canada during January and February, 2013.

The successful applicant will have the opportunity to assist the institute to compile research for policy publications and work closely with the institute's policy staff, focusing on mining and resource policies. The student will have the opportunity to gain practical experience in forming and articulating policy ideas on a range of topics, including Education, Health, Urban Issues and Canada-US Relations.
