

### **Overview**

The Frontier Centre for Public Policy is an independent, Western Canada-based public policy think tank with offices in Winnipeg, Regina and Calgary, and they are looking for an Australian intern for January and February 2013.

The successful applicant would experience public policy outside their own environment, attend Frontier Events and learn about the workings of one of Canada's fastest growing think tanks, working on extensive policy papers into one of the following areas in Housing, Poverty, Health, Education, Aboriginal, Economic, Local Government, and Environmental policy.

#### Requirements

Applicants should have an interest in free market principles, as well as a high level of communication skills.

### Location

Frontier has three offices in Western Canada (Winnipeg, Regina and Calgary). It is anticipated that the intern would spend time in two of the three offices while completing their internship program.

# **Costs**

This internship, in partnership with the Mannkal Foundation, will include flights, accommodation, travel insurance and a small stipend.

If dates permit, the successful applicant will also have the opportunity to travel to Washington DC and attend the Students for Liberty (<a href="http://studentsforliberty.org/">http://studentsforliberty.org/</a>) conference in February 2013.
