

Overview

Mannkal Economic Education Foundation is offering a scholarship to complete an internship in Hong-Kong, including a side trip to Shanghai, China, to attend a conference, this coming winter university break. The internship will be based at the <u>Lion Rock Institute</u> which a free market think-tank in Hong Kong.

The successful applicant would work on public policy projects and learn about the workings of the most economically free country in the world (according to Heritage Foundation's Annual Index of Economic Freedom (<u>http://www.heritage.org/index/ranking</u>). This scholarship also includes the opportunity to attend the <u>International Society for Individual Liberty (ISIL) Shanghai Austrian</u> <u>Economics Summit</u> in Shanghai, China.

The goal of this internship is for the participant to develop and advocate free-market ideas in a different cultural context. The opportunity to learn what free market economists are doing in China promises to be a rewarding end to the internship experience.
