

Refugee Handout

It is interesting that the Federal Government provides a Single Refugee with a monthly allowance of \$1,890.00 and the possibility to receive an additional \$580.00 in Social Assistance. So a single refugee may receive a total of \$2,470.00 per month while a family of four can receive \$9,880.00 per month or \$118,685 per year.

Compare this to a single Australian pensioner who, after contributing to the growth and development of Australia for 40 to 50 years, receives only a monthly maximum of \$1,012.00 in old age pension and Guaranteed Income Supplement. (Maybe our pensioners should apply as refugees!)

Let's send this to all Australians so we can all be ticked off and maybe we can get the refugees to cut back to \$1,012.00 and increase the pensioners' payments to \$2,470.00 so we can enjoy some of the money we are forced to submit to the Government in taxes.
